## The Lies About Prop 50:

When you google a picture of Prop 50, amazingly this one of Governor Newsom pops up showing Newsom with a long Pincocchio nose. Does that mean even Google thinks Newsom was lying about Prop 50?

Newsom said, "We have had enough of Red States changing the rules and gerrymandering the state." He is referring to Texas who had a special election and had enough votes to redraw their state districts to possibly give five more Republican Congressmen the chance to win. But Texas did not have anything written in their state Constitution against such as California does. So, who is really changing the rules? California is, under Newsom's leadership.

Californians worked really hard to pass Prop 20 back in 2010, that made it part of our Constitution that we would have a non-partisan 14 member commission (5 Democrats, 5 Republicans, and 4 no party affiliation) to determine where redistricting needed to be done following the census that is taken every ten years. Prop 50 changes the redistricting back so it will be done by state legislators, where Democrats outnumber Republicans 3 to 1, so, of course the new map will be drawn to the advantage of Democrats.

**Prop 50 Passed by a 63% Margin:** In spite of much hard work by Eagle Forum members, Republicans, and other like-minded conservatives, Prop 50 passed by a wide margin in the Nov. 4 election. Over \$132 million was spent by Democrats—\$13 million on television ads promoting it—all of the ads mentioned Trump's name, or showed pictures of Trump, as if he was the one the voters would be defeating and his attack on "democracy" if they voted for it.

Amazingly, the new map showing the redrawn districts was already finished and sent out in the voter guide to every voter before the November 4th election. Was that not illegal "changing the rules" by Newsom - going ahead and having his state legislators redraw the district map before Prop 50 even passed, and it was authorized to do so?

**Is the Goal a One-Party State?** The new map shows that the former districts represented by five of our favorite Republican Congressmen are now changed and will make it very hard for them to be re-elected. For example, District 2 at the top of the state, a primarily rural, conservative farming area that is 80% Republican and represented by Congressman Doug LaMalfa, also a farmer, has been now so redrawn (gerrymandered) to include parts of Marin and Sonoma County, both very liberal and 60% Democrat. In the 2026 election, La Malfa would be running against ultra liberal Congressman Jared Huffman and would have a very difficult chance to be reelected. The same holds true for four other districts that have Republican Congressmen representing them. Their districts have been changed to include more areas of predominantly Democrats, and they will have a hard time being reelected.

Because of our large population of almost 40 million people, California has 52 Congressmen representing our state, more than any other state. As it is now, only 9 of those are Republican, with 43 Democrats. If Prop 50 holds (there are promised lawsuits against it—saying it was unconstitutional), we will only have 4 Republican Congressmen representing our entire state. Does that sound fair? No, not at all.

**The Battle of the Bridge—An Allegory of Hope:** As some of you who live in Santa Rosa know, there was quite a battle of Prop 50 banners going on - on the pedestrian overpass over highway 101 coming into Santa Rosa on the south side. It was almost a 3 week battle but was finally won by the Republicans, which gave us a little hope. (Continued on page 5)

## Report of our Constitution Day Celebration for the 238th Birthday of the US Constitution, 9/20/25

The program began at 9 a.m. with a welcome by CEO Orlean Koehle. The opening prayer was given by Father Jeffrey Keyes of St. Eugene's Church. Singers Jason Lowry and Terry Lee Crandall gave beautiful renditions of God Bless the USA and Amazing Grace.

As a tribute to honor Charlie Kirk's remarkable life, a short video was shown that was created by Turning Point USA. Our MC was Captain Phil Graf who introduced the rest of the program.

**The first speaker was Debbie Bacigalupi**, a rancher's daughter from Siskiyou County, CA and former candidate for Congress. She told of the many ways our rural property owners are under attack with the destruction of dams that happened in 2023-24



with 4 dams on the Klamath River being destroyed that affects the steady flow of water that used to come to the ranchers and farmers. No longer are there any reservoirs to hold the water for emergencies such as putting out fires, plus, the cleanest form of producing energy – hydraulic is now gone. Debbie showed slides of wolves being introduced into Northern California. Some ranchers are losing hundreds of their sheep and calves. The wolves seldom eat much of their prey. They just love to kill, so most of the animals are left to slowly bleed to death with parts of their bodies missing. Since these wolves are on the endangered species list, any rancher who would dare to shoot one could face years in prison and enormous fines.



**The second speaker was Patrick Wood**, economist from Mesa, Arizona, and author of several books on Technocracy. He told us that he believes the greatest threat to our Constitution and to our freedoms and way of life today is Technocracy and AI. The Technocrats have been planning since back in the 1930s to take over controlling our nation and the world. We are so much closer now with AI. Patrick figures we have maybe three years before AI will have taken over everything, including running governments throughout the world. What can we do? First of all, get informed and get prepared. 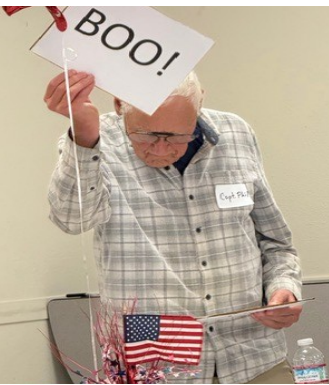

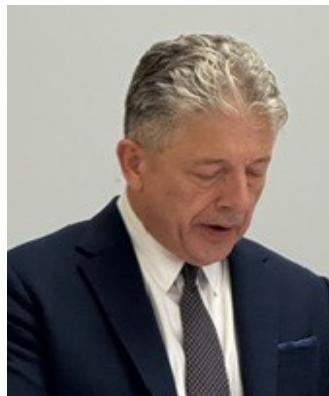

Over nine years, scientists recorded and measured field strengths around dozens of trees in urban and suburban areas. ## **Legislation Report—Federal and California:**

**Federal—Good Bills -HR 1498 and S 669 – Get US Out of the UN** - Reintroduced by Rep. Chip Roy (R-Texas) and Senator Mike Lee (R-Utah) called **the DE-FUND Act** - “Disengaging Entirely From the United Nations Debacle Act, Repeal of UN Participation Act of 1945 (Public Law 79-264 (22 U.S.C. 287 et seq.) Would also get the US out of any affiliate body such as the WHO; and also get the UN out of the US. **Both bills are now in the Foreign Relations Committees.** Chair **Sen. Jim Risch** (R Idaho) 202-224-2752, and House Chair **Rep. Brian Mast** (R Florida) (202) 225-3026, Call and tell them to pass the bills.

**Protecting Parental Rights: One of Trump’s Executive Orders Threatens to Stop all Federal Funding to Schools that Allow Secret Gender Transitions:** The order states that concealing a child’s gender transition from parents may violate federal laws protecting parental rights: Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (PPRA). We hope this can be used to stop the many bills that have gone through in California promoting gender transitions.

**California Bills– One good bill—S JRI - Senate Joint Resolution** – (Sponsor Scott Weiner) **passed unanimously with both Republicans and Democrats voting for it.** It rescinded and nullified all seven applications previously made by the state legislature for the US Congress to call an Article V convention for proposing amendments to the US Constitution.” (Orlean’s book *America Needs Revival, not Revision* tells why an Article V would be so dangerous.)

**The Bad: Newsom signed nearly 800 bills:** Most of them are bad, really bad and worse.

**AB 727 – mandates that all public schools for grades 7-12, must issue student ID cards that show a “suicide hotline” – giving contact numbers for Trevor Space,** that is “LGBTQ-affirming, grooming and anti-parent.” Trevor Space has various chat rooms suggesting a series of clubs for the student to join that are all leftist, many are anti-parent, promoting LGTBQ beliefs and gender confusion.

**AB 495 – “Family Preparedness Plan of 2025”** really is a **plan that would make more possible “children kidnapping and trafficking.”** Authored by Assemblywoman Celeste Rodriguez (San Fernando-D), the bill claims to provide compassionate solutions for immigrant families facing sudden separations due to detention or deportation of parents.” But critics—including attorneys, parental-rights advocates, and faith-based organizations—warn it dangerously redefines guardianship, strips away parental rights, and **creates legal loopholes that make kidnapping children easy.** Attorney Erin Friday calls it **“a child trafficker’s and kidnapper’s dream bill.”**

**AB 749, the so-called Youth Sports for All Act,** is a Trojan horse. Pretending to bring “equity” in sports, it

Undermines fairness and further cements the participation of biological males in girls’ and women’s sports. This bill shifts the focus to a political agenda that undermines the integrity of competition.

**SB 403 – makes Physician-Assisted Suicide Permanent.** It removes the 2031 expiration date from California’s “End of Life Option Act,” enshrining assisted suicide permanently into law. Legalizing assisted suicide abandons the elderly, the disabled, and the sick, sending the message that some lives aren’t worth living. California should expand palliative care and compassion, not normalize killing.

**AB 1084 -authorizes minors to change their sex and name on their birth certificate without full parental consent.** This law requires state officials to issue new identity documents within 6 weeks, erasing biological truth and replacing it with self-declared identity. If only one parent signs, the court notifies the other, but if a parent will not sign because they do not believe their child’s proposed gender identity aligns with their biological sex, the court will not consider their objection

### **Newsom Vetoes the Following Bad Bills:**

**AB 86 -** would have required the California State Board of Education to adopt instructional materials for K-8 health Education all based on the anti-family 2019 curriculum frameworks requiring junior highers and high schoolers to be positively taught to accept masturbation, oral sex, teen fornication, homosexuality, bisexuality, transsexuality, abortion, and more.

**SB 771 -** would have banned conservatives and other reasonable Californians from social media platforms (threatening Meta, X, and others with huge fines for permitting a user’s “harmful rhetoric” about “race, religion, gender, sexual orientation, immigration status, or other protected characteristics.”

### **Summation of What We Can Do to Try to Effect Change:**

Become educated, join with like-minded people—there is strength in numbers—attend BOS meetings, City Council meetings, school board meetings, write letters to the editor, call in on talk radio, and speak out. We are supposed to have a Representative government. But if we never let our voices be heard, then California will become even more a one-party state, and we Republicans will slowly have no voice at all.

There are many examples of elected officials: city councilmen, supervisors and school board members listening to their constituents and making correct decisions in favor of what has been requested of them. But if we never speak out or let our voices be heard, what kind of a government can we expect to have? It will no longer be a Republic—it will become a total Democracy where only the Majority rule.
